## PARTNER UPDATE -Dajte nam sansu

We recently met with our partners in Bosnia, "Dajte nam Sansu", which means "Give Us a Chance" to talk about the upcoming new year and check in on how their organization and families were doing. Dajte nam Sansu gives families of children with disabilities a chance. The number of families and individuals that they serve has expanded and they have BIG plans for the upcoming year!

In Bosnia, when family has a child with disabilities, it can be difficult for the parents to work, for kids to attend school, or for them to get appropriate transportation. This is where Dajte nam Sansu steps in. They use the mobile van to transport individuals to doctor appointments, therapy visits, and planned excursions around the city. They also use the mobile van to deliver food and medical supplies and also do home-based services with therapists and other professionals.

They also provide regular support services and respite nights for the families that they serve. These services and the community they've created is so life-giving to the children and families they support. (continued on next page)

Lost Sparrows supports Dajte nam Sansu because their support of vulnerable families helps prevent children from becoming orphans. The families that Dajte nam Sansu cares for have no other options for receiving supports and services.

With Lost Sparrows support, Dajte nam Sansu is able to serve around 865 families. Lost Sparrows has been supporting their mobile van for the past few years and we want to increase the support that we offer these vulnerable families. In 2023, we want to provide their staff and families with traumainformed trainings and want to visit them in April.
